

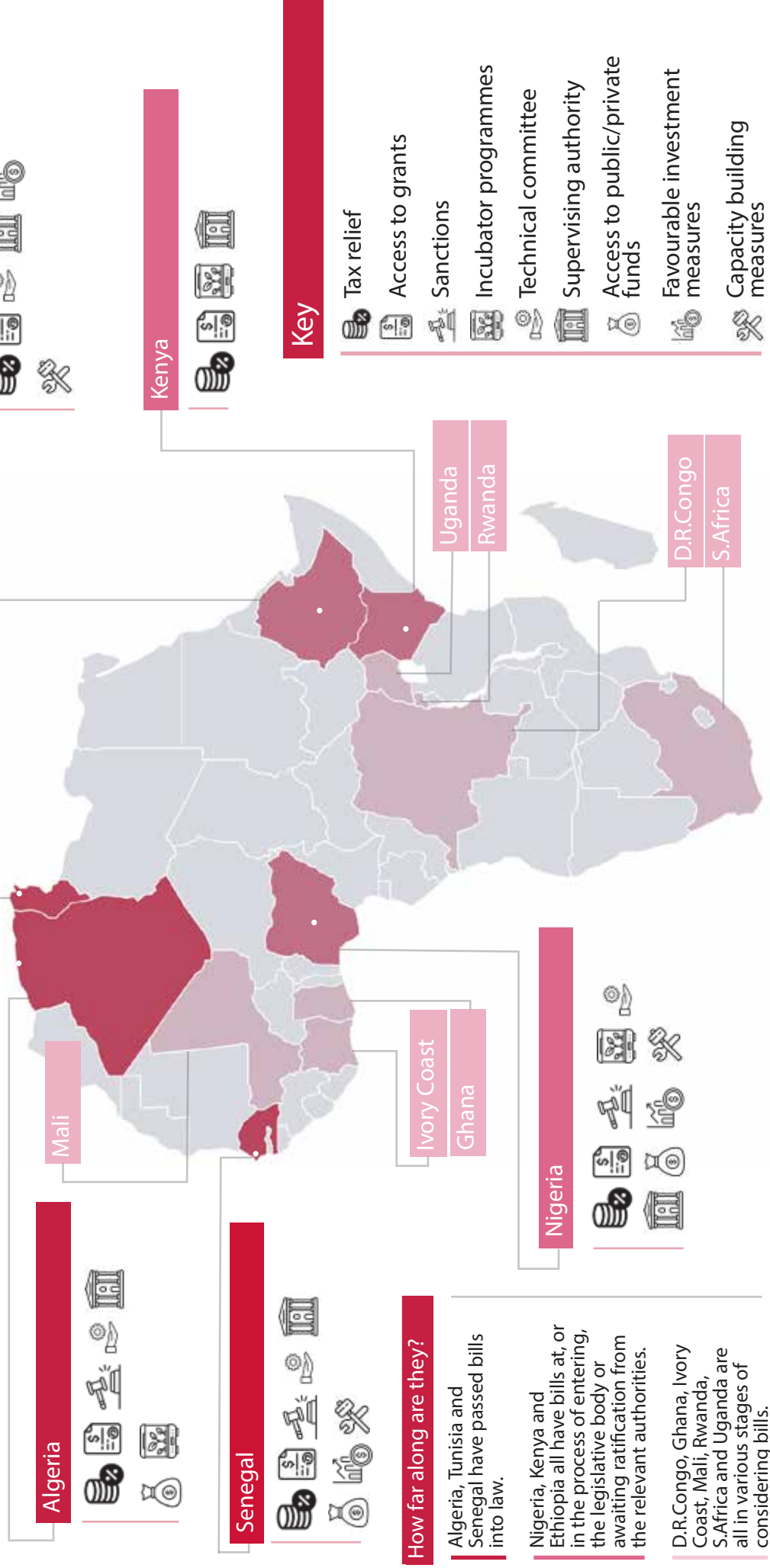


START-UP LAWS IN AFRICA: HIGHLIGHTS AND COMPARISONS

Since October 2018 when the startup act was introduced...



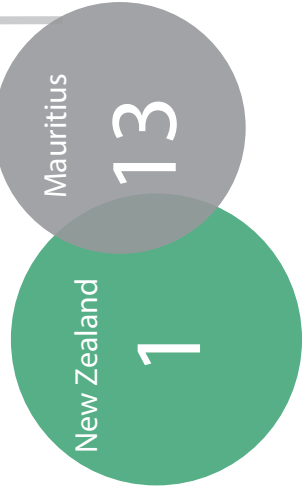
21% of startups registered have been female owned
